Bainbridge Performing Arts (BPA) June Gallery “The Consciousness of Objects” - Photographs by Scott Williams

Photographer **Scott Williams** showcases his work at BPA this June in an exhibit entitled **“The Consciousness of Objects.”** Though he considers himself a nature photographer, Scott says, “I don’t seek or find the genius of the natural world solely in the wilderness, but everywhere and in everything. I find it particularly striking at the fringes of human society, where the power and logic of the natural world imbues even the most mundane objects with beauty and grace. Order appears where I expect chaos – shapes, colors, and textures that are too perfect to be random. In alleys, parking lots, and abandoned buildings, I find an endless stream of plants and objects with personalities – all sitting just outside human attention and quietly proclaiming their individuality. There is beauty, humor, and dignity in the inanimate world all around us, and this I believe to be a reflection of the universal consciousness that flows through everything, the one behind the many, the ocean beneath the waves.”

Scott’s discovery of photography charted a meandering path beginning in 1978. He was originally aiming towards a medical career, but photography diverted his attention and held it. He ultimately found his career in the film business as a cinematographer and director, but he has never stopped recording the “iotas” of the world.
